



Lovely park in English landscape style, with botanical rarities, open from 8am to sunset.

3. Faxe Kalkbrud (Limestone Quarry) Visit the "white" limestone quarry with the blue lakes for a fossil hunt.

4. Ringsted Outlet

5. Roskilde

6. Stevns Klint (Cliff)

Marvellous UNESCO World Heritage site with a unique view across Køge Bay.

Denmark's most fun amusement park brimming with roller coasters, roundabouts, rafting and a lot more.


9. Copenhagen

Køge is brimming with history

Køge is an old medieval town with an exciting history for you to discover, on your own or accompanied by a guide.

Town centre

First time visitors always come in for a surprise at the sight of the beautiful, well preserved town centre with its long rows of Renaissance houses still following a medieval town plan. So take a walk through the charming medieval town centre with your family. Have a peep into the old courtyards or visit the market on a Wednesday or Saturday with its full trade in flowers, fresh fruit and vegetables.

City walk

A free city walk guide is available, describing the old market town that was founded in 1288 by King Erik Menved. Should you want to be accompanied by a personal guide, telling you about the exciting history of Køge, it is possible to book a tour guide with VisitKøge where you can also pick up the city walk guide mentioned.

The history of Køge is still written...

The area around Køge Station and Køge Town Hall is one of the new neighbourhoods in Køge, where unmistakably history melts into the present. Here the street called Strædet invites to cosy shopping and delicious food or a visit to the huge Nordisk Film Cinema. The new buildings and the old heart of town stand side by side.

Then pop down around Køge Harbour and the area to the south where the most recent part of town is springing up. Enjoy the recreational areas and Søndre Strand beach that is located here, just a stone's throw away from the town centre.

Pick up a treasure map at VisitKøge

- and go experience Køge in a different way.

Experience old Køge with your children and a "treasure map" in hand. You get your free treasure map at VisitKøge, and then it is up to you to solve the puzzles throughout the old part of town.





City walks in Køge

You can join a guided walk in Køge during spring and late summer. Be acquainted with the city's exciting history and hear about life in yesterday's Køge. The tours follow various themes, such as courtyards, the harbour, city centre, basements or the church.

All walks take place in the evening and are guided in Danish only.



The Market Square Torvet and the small adjoining streets are brimming with specialist stores, restaurants, pubs and cafés. The Market Square offers open air eateries in the summer months, a fine opportunity to enjoy the cosy atmosphere in town over a refreshment.





Visit the new Søndre Havn

Right now, a totally new residential district, Søndre Havn, is shaping up in a marvellous location between the historic city centre of Køge, the harbour, the beach and the sea.

Modern architecture

The area is even now a great attraction to visitors interested in architecture. There will be 11 new blocks of flats to study from the spring of 2021, all with a clear statement of architectural diversity. Several trend-setting architecture firms have already set their marks here in a context laid down in the development plans for Køge Kyst.

Green areas and climate protection

2021 is also the first year to present a unique characteristic feature of Søndre Havn – the commons, which are extensive green urban spaces inviting to social contact, all while ensuring climate protection as well as biodiversity.

Søndre Havn adjoins Køge's scenic beach meadow with its rare and hardy plants. Take a walk on Engkanten, on the border between the new neighbourhood and the beach meadow. This is a new promenade that also serves as protection against flooding and sea water rise.

Temporary urban spaces and art

Worth visiting are also the temporary urban spaces with facilities for young and old alike — such as "Tidsrummet" (Time Space) to have a swing on its strawberry buoys, and "Opdagelsen" (Discovery) with an outdoor kitchen and town gardens.



Follow the steles along "The Thread".

You may also look forward to an art experience. Several blocks have their own works of art – e.g. Christian Schmidt-Rasmussen's richly coloured wall paintings or Tina Maria Nielsen's bronze sculpture inspired by a whale bone.

Another interesting sight is "Skibet" (The Ship), the hallmark in the gateway to the building of the same name, inspired by a 500 year old medieval ship that emerged on the construction site in 2018.



In conclusion, Køge Kyst has created "Tråden" (The Thread), a cultural route along which a number of concrete steles serve as guides through an area in transformation. The steles also depict small stories from Køge's city history, and each of them presents its own work of art, created and adapted to their site by Cai-Ulrich von Platen.



History, atmosphere & ambience

As a tourist in Køge Municipality you will find everything you could possibly wish for: History, atmosphere and ambience.

The municipality's biggest town, Køge is a very beautiful medieval town with a delicately restored centre and a wonderful market square, which is today one of the best preserved in Denmark of its kind. In Køge you will also find Denmark's oldest town hall still in use as the municipality's administration centre. The town hall dates from c. 1552.

The town has a well organised commercial life with shops for every taste. Several shops are hidden behind the house fronts in the old part of town. It is also here, in the courtyards, that you can enjoy a cool refreshment to the tunes of live music in summer.

Splendid natural experiences

The local countryside has great experiences in store for you: beaches in the east and woods in the west, such as the 22 km Køge River Path ending at the hills Regnemarks Bakker and Dyndet, old bogland with a rich flora and fauna. Here is also a charming café, Malerklemmen.

Køge Municipality has an excellent infrastructure and good rail connections to Copenhagen as well as Roskilde and Næstved. By way of example, it only takes 20 minutes to reach Copenhagen Central Station from Køge Nord Station.







Køge is surrounded by beautiful countryside and lovely beaches, so you may look forward to wonderful scenic experiences during your stay.

Dyndet near Borup

Dyndet near Borup is a lovely moorland area with a bathing lake, a popular goal for a day out, located about 17 km west of Køge. Marvellous view from the ridge round the lake.

Kimmerslev Lake

Beautiful lake in a scenic area. A heart path encircles the lake. One of Denmark's oldest medieval mills, Kimmerslev Watermill, is located nearby. The lake is used for bathing and angling (fishing cards on sale at Borup Library).

Køge Å Path

A 22 km long cycling and walking path. This gravelled path starts from Køge Ridge, following Køge River to the west to Humleore and further on to Borup Station. Part of the path is disabled friendly.

Køge Ridge

Køge Ås is the city's most popular recreational area, located just about 700 metres from the Market Square. A visit to the tall hills and steep slopes is definitely recommendable. The highest point is 24 metres above sea level.

Tangmose Wood

Tangmoseskoven is a cosy little wood on Køge Marina with control points for orienteering races (findvej.dk). The viewpoint Havhøj is also worth a visit with its unique view across the marina to the city of Køge. Highly suitable for a break on your cycling tour.

The roof gardens

View Køge from above from one of the public roof gardens. Bring the whole family along for a visit to the Exercise Garden, the Play Garden or the Wood Garden. The gardens are laid out above the shops in Rådhusstrædet from where they are accessed.

Beaches in Køge

Køge Bay is noted for its fine beaches with plenty of sand and highly child friendly bathing. Køge has three bathing beaches, Ølsemagle Revle, Køge Nordstrand and Søndre Strand in addition to the excellent harbour bath in Køge Marina.

Ølsemagle Revle

Enjoy the rich birdlife from the bird tower or a day on the wide sandy beach that has very shallow and child friendly waters.



Cycling suggestions in Køge

Your holiday activity could be a cycling tour through the scenic areas along Køge Bay.

One tour suggestion is to follow the Køge Ås ridge on the 22 km Køge River Path (Køge Å-stien) ending in the hills of Regnemarks Bakker outside Borup west of Køge. VisitKøge hands out a cycling folder including 8 different tours. The tours have a length of 6, 15, 25 or 45 km, all of them going through beautiful scenery in and around Køge.







Køge Municipality offers some of Denmark's most interesting fishing waters. Here is the alluring Køge Bay with its huge silvery sea trouts and fat Atlantic cods, in addition to pretty lakes with fierce predatory fish, and both Køge River and Tryggevælde River hold record big perch, pike and trout.

KØGE BAY is a unique brackish water habitat with a versatile fishstock and exciting fishing in store for you. The sea trout and perch have a splendid time here, and according to season you will also meet ide, mullet, garfish, cod and flatfish. Should you want a try at coast fishing, you will need a pair of waders, since it is often necessary to wade to the second or third sandbar to reach the belt of seaweed used by the sea trouts for habitat.

ØLSEMAGLE REV may offer good sea trout fishing in spring and autumn. Leave your car in the public car park at the end of the road, Revlen, north of Køge. Be aware of traffic regulations, however.

STRANDVEJEN is on a stretch south of Køge an excellent place to go for sea trout. Parking is possible in a public car park near the water opposite Vallø Camping. From


here you can go angling for 1.5 km to the south until you reach the preservation area starting by Vedskølle River.

SMALL BOAT AND TROLL FISHING is possible in the entire Køge Bay, with excellent chances to catch big sea trout, small cod and flatfish. There is usually also lee for the predominant Danish westerly winds. You will find a boat ramp with a pay machine in Køge Marina.

KØGE HARBOUR is very attractive during the autumn and winter months, offering extremely exciting angling for sea trout and perch. These fish enter the harbour from Køge Bay on their way to Køge River. Several restrictions and preservation rules apply within the harbour. www.fishingindenmark.info shows an interactive map of various fishing grounds around Køge plus information about rules and the various zones.

KØGE RIVER AND TRYGGEVÆLDE RIVER are some of Sealand's very best sea trout streams. Both rivers also throw in huge brackish water perches. In addition, Tryggevælde River is noted for good pike and ide catches. Day cards are required for Tryggevælde River and are on sale at Aktiv Fritid, Torvet 19, 4600 Køge, aktivfritid.dk, tel: 56 63 15 33 or at Køge Sportsfisker forening. koegesportsfiskerforening.dk


LAKE FISHING takes place in lakes like Kimmerslev Sø and Dalby Sø. Kimmerslev Sø is a 94 acre extremely clear watered lake, providing good pike and perch fishing in the months of spring and autumn. Dalby Sø holds excellent stocks of pike, and it also offers roach, bream and tench angling. Fishing licences are sold at Borup Library.



Five fishing platforms are available to the south in Køge Marina. They consist of huge concrete tubes covered by a cast deck with railings.


Anglers have access to a shelter where they will always find a dry corner.

You reach the fishing platforms via the path behind the jetty Bro 8 – and early birds will here have the opportunity to enjoy the sunrise.

All courses are set in wonderful scenery offering peace and quiet for a round with other golf enthusiasts.

Køge Golf Klub

Køge Golf Klub has two courses – the South Course and the North Course. The South Course is an exciting 18 hole park course. Several holes have water challenges, the varied planting includes big trees, and distances between holes are short. The North Course is a rated 9 hole course where summer greens are playable all year round. This course is first of all suitable for short play training. The club has a beautiful clubhouse including a restaurant offering an excellent selection of food and drink. The restaurant is open to everyone.

Vallø Golfcenter

Vallø Golf is located on Stevns just 8 km south of Køge. It is an informal club where everybody says hello to everybody else. Vallø Golf has two spacious courses - one is

the beautifully designed, slightly undulating 18 hole landscape course, the other is a 9 hole pay & play course. The summer greens of the 18 hole course are playable all year round. Golf equipment is availabe for hire, and they have a bookable pro coach. For family fun and games, have a try at Footgolf, playing a football through the 9 hole course. Good food and drink is served in the cosy courtyard with access for everyone.

Køge & Vallø Camping - mini golf

In 2018, Køge & Vallø Camping opened a totally new 18 hole mini golf course that is playable for everyone, independent of age. The course is in a scenic setting on the campsite, offering many cosy hours of fun - but do look out, for it is not particularly easy to get hole-in-one on the quirky course with its tricky constructions.



A canoe trip is a must on a visit to Køge. Canoeing, you will have a waterside view of the town and see the beautiful old houses from behind. This is a fine opportunity to gather the entire family in an activity.

Enjoy a lovely boat ride starting from central Køge. From here it goes to the wood around the Køge Ås ridge, passing the pretty and impressive Gammel-kjøgegaard Manor, and suddenly you find yourself in the wild outdoors, surrounded by trees and utter peace and quiet. No noise reaches you here, just the song of the birds.

Hiring a canoe, you have one and a half hour at your disposal. This time is sufficient to reach Køge Inner Harbour with its small fishing boats and houseboats at anchor side by side, before sailing back to your starting point.

After an active day out, you will probably need a good meal. You are welcome to bring your own hamper to enjoy in the cosy garden where canoes are hired.

Life jackets:

VisitKøge has a large number of life jackets available, but under COVID-19 rules a life jacket must be in "quarantine" for 72 hours after use. It is therefore recommended to book as early as possible to make sure that we have got "clean" jackets ready for you. You are also welcome to bring your own life jackets.

Swimming spots in and around Køge

There are various swimming spots in and around Køge. You will find wide sandy beaches along Køge Bay with plenty of space and wonderful fresh bathing water. Being very shallow, the beaches are extremely child friendly.





Køge Nordstrand

Køge North Beach is found at Køge Marina, north of Køge City. Here is a large car park, from where gravel and paved paths lead down to the very beach. A bathing jetty is set up in summer, enabling visitors to reach a bit deeper water.



Harbour Bath, Køge Marina

In the Harbour Bath there is a bathing platform from which you can get into the water as well as platforms within a short swimming distance. The Harbour Bath is intended for experienced swimmers. You can jump in the water here all year round. Just off the Harbour Bath is the Promenade Bridge. When it is dark, the bridge is illuminated from the water so you can follow the fish and aquatic plant life.



Bathing Lake, Dyndet, Borup

The Bathing Lake (Badesøen) at Dyndet is located beautifully in the southwestern part of Køge Municipality and is a result of earlier massive excavation of gravel. The lake is now a popular goal for a day out. Close to the lake, you can reach the top of one of the ridges via a staircase, to enjoy stunning views.



Køge Søndre Strand

The South Beach is located south of Køge City, surrounded by woods and pretty grass meadows. The beach is incredibly wide and flat and provides fine opportunities for beach play like ball games without disturbing other beach visitors. A bathing jetty is set up in summer.



Revlen, Ølsemagle

Revlen, north of Køge City, invites with its fine and wide sandy beach to glorious beach days. To get to the beach, pass through a protected wildlife reserve with a very rich bird life. You can enjoy views of the reef area from the bird watching tower. A bathing bridge is set up in summer. Here you can also rent kayaks and SUP surfboards.



Køge Swim Centre

Should the weather not permit a beach trip, you can spend a day indoors at Køge Svømmeland. Here are activities available for the whole family, such as the fun pool with toys, water cannon and a countercurrent canal. Speed down the water chute or dive from boards at 1, 3 or 5 m heights. Or you could just relax in the sauna or whirlpool.

Viewpoints in Køge

Køge has several viewpoints offering splendid views across the town of Køge and Køge Bay. On a bright day, there is an incredible panorama view from the tower of Køge Church across Køge Bay and all the way up to Øresund Bridge. You could also have a try on the prize-winning footbridge to Køge Nord Station, which offers a unique view across Køge Bugt Motorway.





Køge Nord Station

Køge Nord railway station, a characteristic and architectural landmark for Køge and also the new gateway for travellers to Copenhagen.





Station Bridge

Have a fine view across town, harbour and station from the Station Bridge. Also suitable for wheelchair users.



Roof Gardens in Køge

The 3 roof gardens offer activity as well as recreation. Located on top of the stores in Rådhusstræde, the gardens are open to the public. A place for peace and quiet and also a playground.



View embankment on Køge Marina

Climb the green embankment to enjoy a beautiful view across the sea. You should also climb the Havhøj hill with a marvellous view of the town of Køge and its red rooftops.



South Pier, Køge Harbour

On the 888 m long pier, you will get very close to the sea and may be watching a large ship entering the harbour. Unique view of the town of Køge from the end of the pier.



Bird Tower at Ølsemagle Revle

Ølsemagle Revle, noted for its rich bird life and many species of wading birds. Visit the view tower to watch the birds. Awesome view across Køge Bay.



Dyndet, west of Køge

Located in the beautiful moorland area, called Dyndet, west of Køge, is "Badesøen" (Bathing Lake), bordered by high slopes and woodland. The slopes are the outermost part of the Køge Ås ridge. Climb to the top, from where there are stunning views of the moors and woods.





At any rate, you will need a parking disc displaying when you have left the car. The parking disc is put on display to the right behind the front windscreen and must be clearly visible from outside. Parking signs indicate how long parking is permitted in a particular place.
